



SCHEDULE - CVP Maintenance of Accreditation Points

This schedule is to be read in conjunction with the *C/9.1 CVP Accreditation & Maintenance Policy and Procedure*.

Ongoing learning

The criteria for structured and unstructured learning activities and the points that are allocated are outlined in the Australian Veterinarian Associations' VetEd program.

Practice in the discipline

Practice in the discipline points will be calculated as follows:

Activity	Cycle	Points
Full time (> 37.5 hrs/week)	Averaged over 12 months	16 points
80% (30-37 hrs/week)	Averaged over 12 months	12 points
60% (22.5 – 29.5 hrs/week)	Averaged over 12 months	8 points
40% (15-22 hrs/week)	Averaged over 12 months	4 points

Engagement with the profession

Engagement with the profession points will be calculated as follows:

Activity	Cycle	Points
Attendance at an ASAV or AVA Annual Conference (full program)	Within the five-year accreditation cycle	15 points
Active engagement with the ASAV Special Interest Group – Committee Service (12-month engagement)	Within the five-year accreditation cycle	15 points
Active engagement with the ASAV Special Interest Group – Special Project Involvement (12-month engagement)	Within the five-year accreditation cycle	15 points
Engagement with and/or involvement in the mentoring of CVP candidates (12-month engagement)	Within the five-year accreditation cycle	15 points
