Protective outerwear

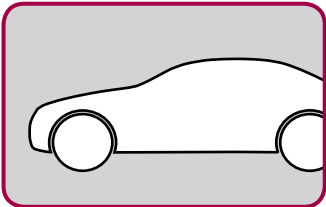
should be worn at all times in the clinic



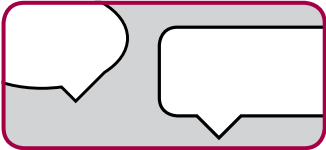
Following our **infection control plan** helps us stay safe at work

Practice vehicles should carry soap, water, sharps container and hand rub



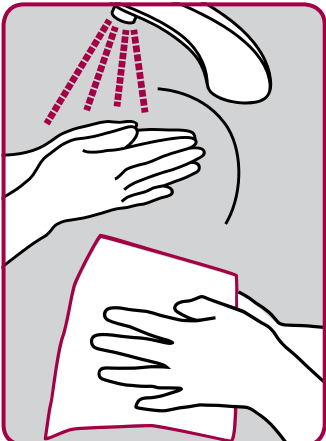
Advise owners about any disease risks to them
